Background knowledge

Wassily Kandinsky was a Russian painter and art theorist. Kandinsky is generally credited as the pioneer of abstract art. Born in Moscow, Kandinsky spent his childhood in Odessa, where he graduated at Grekov Odessa Art school. He enrolled at the University of Moscow, studying law and economics.

What should I already know?

Key Vocabulary Timeline / Diagrams Artist- Someone who creates artwork such as drawings, paintings, collage and sculptures Colour Drawing - A form of art which uses different drawing tools, such as a pencil or charcoal, to make a picture. Line - A curved or straight mark made with a pencil or pen. Sketch book – A book which you record your thoughts and ideas to help with your final design. Pencil - A tool for drawing. Pastels – coloured art material in the form of a stick Charcoal - a small stick of graphite used for drawing. Materials - different things that can be used to draw with. Annotate – To make notes Graded pencil - pencils that create different kind of marks. Tone – exploring light and dark. Annotate- Make notes Texture - how something looks or feels. Shade - exploring light and dark.
