## Key Vocabulary

1	coast	The bits of land that meet a sea or an ocean.
2	beach	An area of sand or pebbles along a shore.
3	sea	Seas are areas of salty water. They are smaller than oceans.
4	cliff	A steep rock face, often on a coast.
5	town	A place where people live and work, with lots of houses, shops, places of work and entertainment.
6	port	A town by a sea or a river that has a harbour.
7	harbour	An area of water next to the coast, often protected from the sea by a thick wall, where ships and boats can shelter.
