Vocabulary

1	Continent	A large landmass. There are 7 in the world.
2	Capital city	The city or town that governs a country
3	Landmark	An object or feature of a town e.g. the Eiffel Tower
4	Human geography	This focuses on how humans have interacted with the environment e.g. its food, clothes, currency and flag
5	Population	The number of people living in a country, city, or area
6	Physical geography	A natural feature that is part of the land such as rivers, mountains.
