## Important Questions

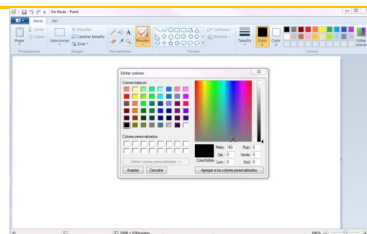
- 1 Can you name lots of different colours?

- 6 Do certain colours remind you of other objects / feelings?



## Key Information

**In the EYFS children should be able to:**

- \*Name colours**
- \*Mix colours (not formally)**
- \*Experiment with and use (experiencing) primary colours**
- \*Name different tools that bring colour**
- \*Use a range of tools to make coloured marks on paper**
- \*Create simple representations of people and other things**
- \*Recognise and describe key features of their own and others' work**
- \*Know that art, (design and craft) is made by artists exhibiting care and skill and is valued for its qualities.**

Colour: full range of, dark, light, shades ...

Tools: brushes, sponges, inks ...

Man-made and natural materials — including hands

Response: talking about personal feelings, to experiences ...

Senses: seeing, doing, touching ...

Scale: big, small ...
