- 4 Can you use a map to locate the two places?
- 5 How can you find out about the localities?
- 6 Who lives in the localities? What type of jobs do they do?



## Key Knowledge

Pupils will develop geographical knowledge and understanding of their country. They will name, locate and identify characteristics of a specific area and learn to compare characteristics of two different geographical areas ( UK and an Island).

Pupils will compare the physical and human geography of the UK and an Island.

Pupils will compare how land and buildings are used in the different locations and begin to give reasons for the differences.

They will begin to ask simple geographical questions and start to investigate the answers
